



Tool: Scorecard Template

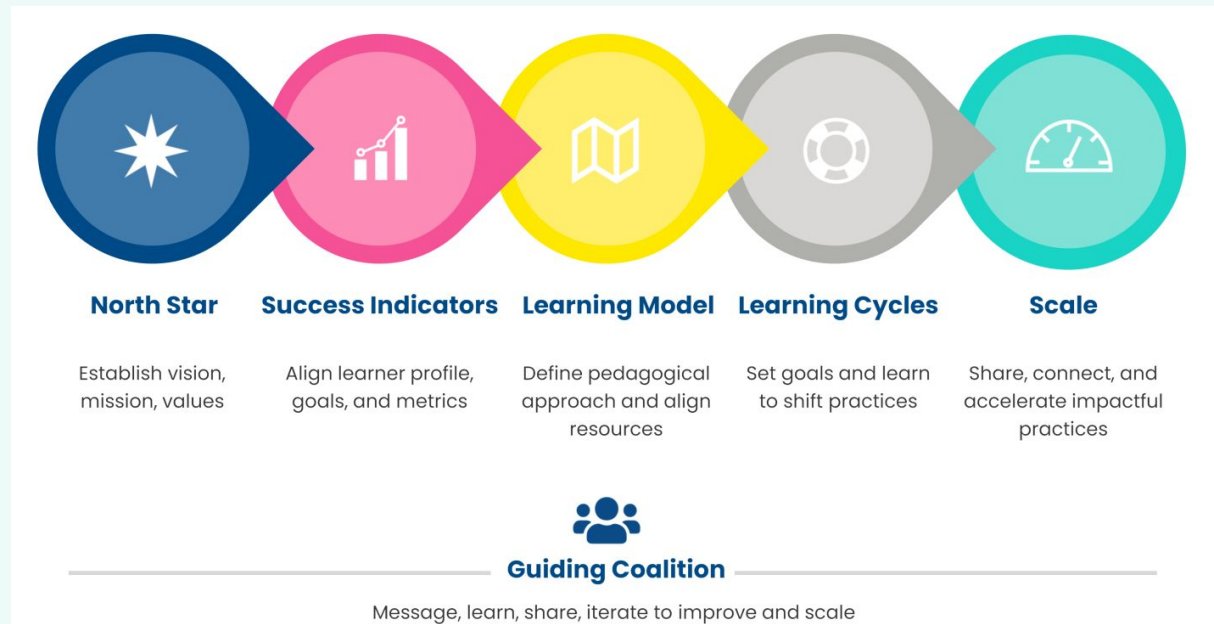
Metrics of success in education are as diverse as the districts, schools, and learners themselves. At the same time, having clear success metrics, monitoring progress in real-time, and implementing a dashboard system that focuses on organizational goals, is key to achieving our desired outcomes.

A simple, easy-to-understand interface, such as a scorecard, that promotes common understanding and informs potential next steps by providing relevant and important information is a powerful tool whether setting goals and success metrics individually, or as a class, school, district, or system.



THE LEARNER-CENTERED JOURNEY

Learner-centered change is a process that happens over time. A scorecard is a helpful tool to track progress along the way.

Desired Outcome	Success Metrics	Source	Current Status (Actual)
TIPS	<i>These should be measurable, tangible goals.</i>	<i>Quantitative or qualitative.</i>	<i>Date + status</i>
<i>These are often aligned to the learner-profile</i>	<i>You can have more than one aligned to an outcome.</i>	<i>Examples: progress reports, checklists, scores, survey results, diagnostic</i>	<i>May be: - a number aligned to success metric - a next step (i.e. create survey).</i>
EXAMPLES	<i>75% of students participate in exhibitions of learning</i>	<i>School checklist + Pictures</i>	<i>Sign-ups open; 30% so far</i>
<i>Student engagement</i>	<i>3rd and 6th grade pilots portfolios with 90% completion</i>	<i>Teacher checklist</i>	<i>70% of students have >3 entries</i>
	<i>70% of students participate in school-provided leadership opportunities</i>	<i>Survey</i>	<i>55% at midpoint of school year</i>
<i>Community engagement</i>	<i>Staff culture survey 8/10; 100% completion</i>	<i>Survey</i>	<i>Survey opens 3/1/24</i>
	<i>Student sense of belonging survey 8/10; 90% completion</i>	<i>Survey</i>	<i>Professional development underway</i>
