



Process

In February 2024, Greenfield Union School District embarked on a mission to redefine its educational approach. A diverse group of teachers, classified staff, administrators, parents, students, community members, and educational experts collaborated intensively. Their objective was straightforward: to analyze and understand the learning experiences of their students thoroughly and to develop a "Portrait of a Greenfield Learner."

They collected diverse data through community surveys, classroom visits, and interviews with students, staff, leaders, and parents. They examined articles, reports, and data sources to identify emerging skills, qualifications, and job roles that will be in demand in the future workforce. This process helped them identify the various learning preferences, strengths, challenges, and future aspirations of their students. They noted how some students excel in group settings while others perform better studying alone, highlighting the diversity in learning styles and needs.

Using this data, the team crafted a detailed representation of their ideal learner, incorporating learning preferences, strengths, challenges, and aspirations. This 'portrait of a learner' aimed to capture the essence and potential of every student in the district.

The team presented this portrait to the community for feedback, incorporating insights from parents, students, staff, and teachers to refine their vision. This iterative process ensured the portrait accurately reflected the community's educational aspirations and students' needs.

The outcome is a clear and actionable vision for education in the district, emphasizing:

- Developing students into insightful thinkers who creatively solve problems by evaluating information from multiple perspectives.
- Fostering collaborative communicators who effectively share ideas and engage in discussions across various platforms.
- Shaping students into progressive global leaders who appreciate diversity, leverage technology, and advocate for practical solutions to real-world problems.
- Encouraging socially aware decisionmakers who empathize with others and make responsible choices.
- Empowering students to take control of their learning journey and showing resilience and creativity in overcoming challenges.

This vision guides the district toward a learnercentered education, ensuring every student has the support and opportunity to thrive.

The final portrait of a learner was a true reflection of the district's commitment to understanding and nurturing ALL students. As we launch our portrait of a Greenfield Student and create the conditions for learner-centered transformation, we will rely on this work as a guiding light to illuminate the path toward a brighter future for all learners.
